SERVICE AGREEMENT
ADDENDUM THREE

THIS ADDENDUM TO THE SERVICE AGREEMENT ("Addendum Three") is entered into this 15th day of March, 2016, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Adams County, Colorado, located at 4430 South Adams County Parkway, Brighton, CO 80601, hereinafter referred to as the "County," and **THE NORMANDY GROUP**, located at 888 16th Street NW, Suite 530, Washington, DC 20006, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor." The County and the Contractor may be collectively referred to herein as the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2014, the County entered into Addendum One #2014.031 with **The Normandy Group**, to provide Federal Lobbying Services; and,

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2015 the County and the Contractor extended the Service Agreement through January 5, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor mutually desire to amend the Service Agreement to extend for one additional year effective January 6, 2016 pursuant to **Section 3 TERM, Paragraph 3.2 Extension Options**.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration set forth herein, the sufficiency of which is mutually acknowledged by the parties, the County and the Contractor agree as follows:

1. The County shall pay the Contractor for the work furnished under Addendum Three in accordance with **Section 4 Payment and Price Schedule Attachments A1-A4 of the Service Agreement RFP 2013.142** for a sum not to exceed one hundred and eight thousand dollars (\$108,000.00).
2. The term of the Service Agreement is extended for one (1) additional year effective through January 5, 2017.
3. The Service Agreement, Addendum One, Addendum Two and Addendum Three contain the entire understanding of the parties hereto and neither it, nor the rights and obligations hereunder, may be changed, modified, or waived except by an instrument in writing that is signed by both parties. Any terms, conditions, or provisions of the Service Agreement, Addendum One and Addendum Two that are not amended or modified by Addendum Three shall remain in full force and effect. In the event of any conflicts between the terms, conditions, or provisions of the Service Agreement, Addendum One, Addendum Two and Addendum Three the terms, conditions, and provisions of Addendum Three shall prevail.
4. The Recitals contained in Addendum Three are incorporated into the body hereof, and accurately reflect the intent and agreement of the parties.

5. Addendum Three may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.
6. Nothing expressed or implied in Addendum Three is intended or shall be construed to confer upon or to give to, any person other than the parties, any right, remedy, or claim under or by reason of Addendum Three or any terms, conditions, or provisions hereof. All terms, conditions, and provisions in Addendum Three by and on behalf of the County and the Contractor shall be for the sole and exclusive benefit of the County and the Contractor.
7. If any provision of Addendum Three is determined to be unenforceable or invalid for any reason, the remainder of Addendum Three shall remain in effect, unless otherwise terminated in accordance with the terms contained in the Service Agreement.
8. Each party represents and warrants that it has the power and ability to enter into Addendum Three, to grant the rights granted herein, and to perform the duties and obligations herein described.

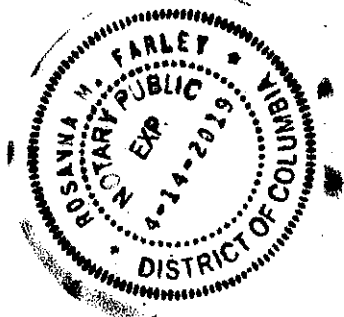
