<p>I. Welcome</p> <p>a. Meeting called to order at 8:36 a.m., roll call via introductions.</p> <p>b. Quorum was present.</p>	<p>Lead: Chair, Emily</p>
<p>II. Business</p> <p>a. Adams County Community Services and Well Being (CSWB) Department presentation by Rebecca Zamora. Currently, the CSWB Department has a variety of responsibilities such as: data analysis, neighborhood snapshots, program partnerships, manages the Community Corrections program. The County’s Emergency Management area is also under this Department which has been working on COVID-19 planning and efforts. Currently, the Neighborhood Services area has also been working on a Tool Shed Program within unincorporated Adams County. The Poverty Reduction/Homelessness area has also been working on providing resources during the pandemic. In 2020, 30,000 residents were served, 5,000 received resource packets, 600 residents received food gift cards. These are done through the drive-thru resource fairs Adams County is holding in partnership with Anythink Libraries. Karla Ojeda has been the Outreach Coordinator for these and other projects.</p> <p>The Advisory Council asked what resources were out for Domestic Violence and Drug and Alcohol Abuse, we have seen a need and not enough resources. <p><i>Motion to approve minutes, seconded and unanimously approved</i></p> <p>c. Financial and Program Reports reviewed. We continue to spend from 3 funding sources: 18-20 grant cycle, CARES, and 21-23 grant cycle. In the 18-20 grant cycle, there was a concern presented by CSBG Specialist regarding a sub-grantee who had not been in communication or had responded. Advisory Council members requested to follow up with sub-grantee agency before we reallocate funds. If funds were to be reallocated, some members suggested to use funding towards housing since the eviction moratorium is to expire June 30, 2021.</p> <p>The 21-23 grant cycle allocated amount showed in the report only notes the 1st year's amount, rather than the full 3-year amount since that is all that has been confirmed (the States confirms amounts per year).</p>
