RESOLUTION APPROVING ACHD’S CLEAN SYRINGE ACCESS PROGRAM

Resolution No. 2022-006

WHEREAS, the Adams County Board of Health serves as the governing body of the Adams County Health Department (“ACHD”) that will function as Adams County’s public health agency beginning in January 2023; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 25-1-520, the Adams County Board of Health may approve a clean syringe exchange program to be implemented by the ACHD; and,

WHEREAS, the Tri-County Health Department, Adams County’s current public health agency, conducted consultations with interested stakeholders and compiled program information as required by C.R.S. § 25-1-520; and,

WHEREAS, ACHD staff updated and tailored this information, as appropriate, and presented this information to the Adams County Board of Health; and,

WHEREAS, the Adams County Board of Health has reviewed the information gathered from interested stakeholders and the plan for the ACHD Clean Syringe Exchange Program prepared by ACHD staff, which complies with the provisions of C.R.S. § 25-1-520.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Adams County Board of Health, that pursuant to C.R.S. §25-1-520, the Board hereby approves the ACHD Clean Syringe Exchange Program as presented by the staff of ACHD.
