Notice of a Proposed Project or Activity Warranting Public Comment

Website Title: Crestone Peak Resources Operating, LLC - Pony Compressor Station - Adams County

Notice is hereby given that an application for a proposed project or activity has been submitted to the Colorado Air Pollution Control Division for the following source of air pollution:

Applicant: Crestone Peak Resources Operating, LLC
Facility: Pony Compressor Station
Natural Gas Compressor Station
SESE Quadrant of Section 19, Township 3S, Range 64W
Adams County

The proposed project or activity is as follows: Initial request to cover ROPE (point 017) under a traditional construction permit (CP 21AD0335). There are 3 ROPE activities: oil tank venting events, engine compressor blowdowns (controlled), and pigging blowdowns and purges. Additionally, the applicant requests to change coverage of the condensate tank (point 016) from a GP08 to a traditional construction permit (CP 23AD0497). These two permit applications have been reviewed together, since they are both necessary to classify the facility as synthetic minor.

The facility is in the severe ozone nonattainment and is synthetic minor for VOC NANSR and OP programs.

The Division has determined that this permitting action is subject to public comment per Colorado Regulation No. 3, Part B, Section III.C due to the following reason(s):

- the source is requesting a federally enforceable limit on the potential to emit in order to avoid other requirements

The Division has made a preliminary determination of approval of the application.
