RESOLUTION ADOPTING REGULATION NO. O-22 ON-SITE WASTEWATER SYSTEMS

Resolution No. 2022-004

WHEREAS, the Adams County Board of Health (“Board of Health”) serves as the governing body of the Adams County Health Department (“ACHD”) that will function as Adams County’s public health agency beginning in January 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health has proposed Regulation No. O-22, Adams County Health Department Regulations for On-Site Wastewater Treatment Systems (“Regulation O-22”); and

WHEREAS, Regulation O-22 has been designed to comply with the On-site Wastewater Treatment System Act, C.R.S §25-10-101, et seq. (the “Act”), and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (“CDPHE”) Water Quality Control Commission On-Site Wastewater Treatment System Regulation, Regulation No. 43, 5CCR 1002-43 (“Regulation 43”); and

WHEREAS, ACHD has given the general public twenty (20) days written notice of the time and place of the public hearing to review Regulation O-22 pursuant to the requirements of the Act and Regulation 43; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health held a public hearing on October 20, 2022 to consider adoption of Regulation O-22; pursuant to the requirements of the Act and Regulation 43 and the Board of Health desires to adopt Regulation O-17

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that after proper notice and a public meeting as required by the Act and Regulation 43, that the proposed Regulation No. O-22 On-site Wastewater Treatment Systems, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, a copy of which has been presented to and circulated among the members of the Board of Health, are hereby approved and adopted by the Board of Health on the 20th day of October 2022, to be effective as of December 5, 2022.
