RESOLUTION ADOPTING FEE SCHEDULE FOR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Resolution No. 2022-005

WHEREAS, the Adams County Board of Health ("Board of Health") serves as the governing body of the Adams County Health Department ("ACHD") that will function as Adams County's public health agency beginning in January 2023; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes, Sections C.R.S. 25-1-508(5)(j) and C.R.S. 25-10-107(1), the Board of Health is authorized to assess fees for environmental health services; and

WHEREAS, ACHD has given the general public twenty (20) days written notice of the time and place of the public hearing to review the proposed fee schedule for environmental health services; and

WHEREAS, the ACHD has determined, and has taken such action and made such investigations as are necessary, in its judgment, to support its determination that the proposed fees for environmental health services are fair, reasonable, and consistent with state statute and regulation;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health adopts the attached **Exhibit A**, proposed Fee Schedule for Environmental Health Services, to become effective January 1, 2023.
