The Salvation Army Safe Parking Program

-Operations Plan

Housing Now is located at 2821 W 65th Place in Westminster Colorado. Up to ten outdoor parking spaces may be located at this address and the case management team will work with those participants as well as other safe parking locations throughout Adams County. Participants will be allowed to park in the lot starting at 6PM each day and must leave the lot no later than 8AM the following morning. Each participant will be given a fire extinguisher and a CO detector . There will be a parking lot monitor employed by the Colorado Safe Parking Initiative who will check participants in and out each day as well as serve as an emergency contact overnight.

The staffing proposal includes one Lead Case Manager and one Housing Navigator/Case Manager working a flexible schedule to meet clients when it is best for the participant. Staff will coordinate referrals through the Colorado Safe Outdoor Parking initiative. Housing Now will utilize the Housing First model and Rapid Rehousing to provide permanent housing outcomes for identified households from the safe parking location at the Housing Now site and throughout Adams County's Safe Parking sites. Housing Now anticipates connecting to 70 individuals. Through providing rapid rehousing and case management services Housing Now expects to lease up 35 households that includes 70 individuals by the end of 2024 and into early 2025, with continued stabilization support resulting in a 70% positive housing rate through 2025. The program will provide ongoing case management and varied rental assistance to households through the end of the contract period.

Safe Parking at The Salvation Army/ Housing Now 2821 W 65th Place, Westminster CO 80221

Written Explanation

Safe Parking provides our community neighbors that have been priced out of housing and are currently residing in their vehicles with a safe place to park from 6 PM - 8AM daily. We are partnering with Colorado Safe Parking Initiative in providing a Safe Parking Site. CSPI will provide the porta potty, hand washing station and hire a participant to be the site leader and report any emergencies or issues with behaviors of the participating neighbors. We also have ARPA funding through Adams county that will provide money for rental assistance, Housing Navigation, and Case Management. The Housing Now team will be working from 11:30-8PM, M-F.

Housing Now is partnering with Adams County and Colorado Safe Parking Initiative and hopes to use a portion of the parking lot located at 2821 W 65th Place.

- CSPI does screening, intake, and referral to Housing Now. This includes a background check.
- CSPI provides a porta-potty, hand washing station and WIFI hotspot if needed.
- CSPI provides a paid overnight attendant to check in participants, ensures participants adhere to the outlined rules and calls police for any disturbance of the peace.
- Accepted candidates are issued a permit for as many nights as needed.
- Participants sign agreements for behavior while on site.
- No drugs/alcohol allowed on site
- Participants are required to use the lot a minimum of 4 nights a week or they lose their permit.
- TSA provides 20 parking spaces for up to 10 cars from 6PM 9AM daily.

- TSA provides access to electricity, laundry services and food pantry when food is available.
- TSA provides video monitoring of the parking lot 24/7
- Housing Now will provide case management services and RRH assistance to participants (funded by Adams County) with the goal of participants exiting from safe parking to permanent housing.

<u>Housing Now expects to assist up to 35 individuals with permanent housing options with this project by 3/31/2025</u>
