Notice of a Proposed Project or Activity Warranting Public Comment

Notice is hereby given that an application for a proposed project or activity has been submitted to the Colorado Air Pollution Control Division for the following source of air pollution:

Applicant: Crestone Peak Resources Operating, LLC
Facility: Crow 3-64 29-30 Battery
Well Production Facility
NESE quadrant of Section 29, Township 3S, R64W
Adams County

The proposed project or activity is as follows: With this submittal, Crestone is requesting a facility wide permit which will consists of the following emission sources:

- Four (4) above ground 500-barrel fixed roof condensate storage tanks (point 002)
- Two (2) above ground 500-barrel fixed roof produced water tanks (point 003)
- Truck loadout of crude oil from tanks (point 004)
- Routine or predictable gas venting (point 006)
- Two (2) Caterpillar G3306TA (203 hp) compressor engines (point 007, 008)
- One (1) PSI 11.1l Turbo Charged (272 hp) generator engine (point 009)

A cancellation for point 005 (gas venting) was received 7/18/2023, since the point no longer exists as of 6/25/2023. The facility is located in the severe ozone nonattainment area and is synthetic minor for VOC NANSR, PSD, and TV-OP, NOX NANSR and TV-OP, CO TV-OP, and n-hexane.

The Division has determined that this permitting action is subject to public comment per Colorado Regulation No. 3, Part B, Section III.C due to the following reason(s):

- the source is requesting a federally enforceable limit on the potential to emit in order to avoid other requirements

The Division has made a preliminary determination of approval of the application.
