

Adams County Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP) Application

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Adams County NTCP. Educational materials regarding traffic in neighborhoods are available immediately and do not require the completion of this application. Contact us at 720.523.6875 or via email at PWTraffic@adcogov.org for yard signs and more.

If concerns persist, you may request support for options that involve engineering elements (either visual or physical) to support traffic calming. The program works in a sequential and escalating manner, so Tier 1 elements must be explored before a neighborhood is eligible to apply for Tier 2 mitigation.

Tier 1 Engineering — **Visual Elements** include items such as signing, striping, or temporary driver speed feedback signs. To begin the process, please fill out and submit this application form. Staff will complete a review and identify appropriate next steps.

If Tier 1 Visual Elements are not considered successful and several residents remain concerned, the neighborhood may apply for **Tier 2 Engineering – Physical Elements**. These include construction-based changes such as curb extensions or speed tables. To begin this process, fill out this application (including the section requiring additional sponsors) and submit it to Adams County Public Works. Staff will review eligibility, complete data collection and evaluation, and, if appropriate, complete a mitigation plan. The neighborhood will then be asked to complete a petition process to ensure a majority of the neighborhood supports the plan before project prioritization and construction scheduling can occur.
