How, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board of Commissioners, of the County of Adams, State of Colorado, proclaims April 20 and 28, and May 1, 2024, as the

and encourages all residents to honor these celebrations and the contributions made by the local and international Bahá'í communities toward lasting peace.
