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### Introduction

When young people are connected to their communities through education, employment, and economic opportunity, the incidence of youth and community violence is reduced. The presence of youth and community violence in the U.S. has been steadily growing with homicide as the second leading cause of death for teens and young adults aged 15-24. Structural racism and oppression have caused disparities in community violence. This has had, and continues to have, damaging effects on a number of outcomes, as demonstrated by the social determinants of health (SDoH), which are the conditions in the environments where people are born, live, learn, work, play, worship, and age that affect a wide range of health, functioning, and quality-of-life outcomes and risks. The impact of historic and continued structural racism on SDoH has caused and exacerbated health inequities.

This report evaluates risk and protective factors relating to youth and community violence across 5 domains: community conditions, economy, education, health, and housing. Protective factors protect people from experiencing potentially traumatic events, such as neglect or violence. Risk factors increase the chances someone will experience a potentially traumatic event. Identifying the existing strengths and assets within a community can build resilience and help to prevent youth and community violence.







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
### **Total Population by Age**

### Population Under Age 18 by Census Tract







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### **Community Conditions**

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#### **Entropy Index**

Communities are stronger when there are more <u>opportunities for community</u>. The Entropy Index is a measure showing levels of distribution among racial/ethnic groups within a community. Values range from 0 to 1; 0 indicates an uneven distribution of the racial/ethnic groups while 1 indicates an even distribution. When communities are racially integrated, this results in <u>more economic opportunity and equitable access to resources</u>. Reducing barriers to community connectedness and dismantling systems that result in inequitable access to opportunities could help to reduce community violence.

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### **Percent Area Covered by Parks**

Studies show that <u>increasing the amount of parks and other green spaces has resulted in lowering crime rates</u>, especially in urban communities. Ensuring that people have shared, outdoor space within a reasonable distance to where they live could help to reduce youth and community violence.



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### Income Inequality (Gini Index)

Income inequality is a result of many compounding factors such as <u>educational opportunity</u>, job availability, and historical discrimination. When a small subset of a community owns the highest share of the wealth, this can create concentrated disadvantage that perpetuates structural racism and exacerbates existing discrimination. Studies have shown that areas with a high degree of income inequality are <u>far more likely to experience violence</u>. Ensuring there is equal access to not only basic needs but also a wide variety of educational, personal, and professional opportunities to promote financial stability that results in earning generational wealth may help to reduce youth and community violence.



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#### **Connected Youth**

Connected youth are youth ages 16 to 19 who are either enrolled in school, employed, or both. Recent studies indicate that connected youth are less likely to commit crimes. Experiencing incarceration as a young person can impact them for the rest of their life. Ensuring that young people have a place within their communities can improve social cohesion and connectedness for not just youth, but for the whole community.







Recent studies have shown that children who were enrolled in pre-kindergarten education were far less likely to be arrested for violence. 

















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#### **Presence of Severe Housing Problems**

The absence of safe, quality, affordable housing <u>can have detrimental effects on an individual's health.</u> When a home is overcrowded, lacks a kitchen, lacks plumbing facilities, or cost-burdens the occupant, this can be highly stressful. Increasing access to affordable, quality housing has been proven to <u>reduce the rates of incarceration among youth.</u> Creating pathways for access to housing and for the remediation of housing that poses risks to health <u>may assist in reducing youth and community violence.</u>




