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## Introduction

When young people are connected to their communities through education, employment, and economic opportunity, the incidence of youth and community violence is reduced. The presence of youth and community violence in the U.S. has been steadily growing with homicide as the second leading cause of death for teens and young adults aged 15-24. Structural racism and oppression have caused disparities in community violence. This has had, and continues to have, damaging effects on a number of outcomes, as demonstrated by the social determinants of health ( SDoH ), which are the conditions in the environments where people are born, live, learn, work, play, worship, and age that affect a wide range of health, functioning, and quality-of-life outcomes and risks. The impact of historic and continued structural racism on SDoH has caused and exacerbated health inequities.

This report evaluates risk and protective factors relating to youth and community violence across 5 domains: community conditions, economy, education, health, and housing. Protective factors protect people from experiencing potentially traumatic events, such as neglect or violence. Risk factors increase the chances someone will experience a potentially traumatic event. Identifying the existing strengths and assets within a community can build resilience and help to prevent youth and community violence.

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## Entropy Index

Communities are stronger when there are more opportunities for community, The Entropy Index is a measure showing levels of distribution among racial/ethnic groups within a community. Values range from 0 to $1 ; 0$ indicates an uneven distribution of the racial/ethnic groups while 1 indicates an even distribution. When communities are racially integrated, this results in more economic opportunity and equitable access to resources. Reducing barriers to community connectedness and dismantling systems that result in inequitable access to opportunities could help to reduce community violence.

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## Income Inequality_(Gini Index)

Income inequality is a result of many compounding factors such as educational opportunity, job availability, and historical discrimination. When a small subset of a community owns the highest share of the wealth, this can create concentrated disadvantage that perpetuates structural racism and exacerbates existing discrimination. Studies have shown that areas with a high degree of income inequality are far more likely to experience violence. Ensuring there is equal access to not only basic needs but also a wide variety of educational, personal, and professional opportunities to promote financial stability that results in earning generational wealth may help to reduce youth and community violence.

The absence of safe, quality, affordable housing can have detrimental effects on an individual's health. When a home is overcrowded, lacks a kitchen, lacks plumbing facilities, or cost-burdens the occupant, this can be highly stressful.
