New Purchase for Cash Sale from a Colorado Dealer

How to Title and register a vehicle that was purchased from a Colorado Dealership with cash.

When an individual purchases a vehicle with cash from a Colorado dealership, the dealership typically provides the necessary documents either in person or via certified mail. It is essential to keep the entire packet intact and bring all documents to the appropriate office.

Failure to register before your temporary registration expires may result in a \$25 late fee being assessed the following day, with an additional \$25 fee accruing each month thereafter, up to a maximum of \$100.

Who Should Complete This Process?

You are a current or new resident of Adams County who purchased a vehicle with cash at a Colorado Dealer; and

You are a listed owner of the vehicle.

What is Required to Complete this Process?

Those who meet the above criteria, will need to bring the following documents to any Adams County Motor Vehicle location:

Secure and Verifiable Identification (SVID)

SVID must be provided by the owner of the record. Examples of SVID are available at www.adcogov.org/motor-vehicle.

Proof of Current Insurance that Complies with Colorado Insurance Requirements

- \$25,000 for bodily injury or death to any one person in an accident;
- \$50,000 for bodily injury or death to all persons in any one accident; and
- \$15,000 for property damage in any one accident.

DR 2698 Verification of Vehicle Identification Number

Commonly called a "VIN Verification," the form can only be completed by licensed Colorado dealerships, Colorado law enforcement, licensed Colorado emissions, the County Clerk (at their discretion), or County Assessor (at their discretion) for titles that are not Colorado titles. Adams County will complete VIN Verifications in our offices for a fee www.adcogov.org/vin-inspections.

Weight Slip

- Weight slips are required on all motor homes and trucks that have an empty weight of more than 4,500 pounds; and
 - o the vehicle has been altered by more than 300 pounds; or
- Trailers that are more than 2,000 pounds.

Proof of Passing Emissions

Commonly called a "smog test." Please visit www.aircarecolorado.com for gas emission information and requirements. Alternatively, please visit www.dmv.colorado.gov/diesel-vehicles for diesel emission information and requirements.

Proof of Ownership for the Vehicle

Generally, the dealership will provide the most current title. It should be properly signed off. If the title is not a Colorado title, a DR 2698 will be required. Please see the information above on the DR 2698 Verification of Vehicle Identification Number. Please call our office, 720-523-6010, for additional requirements.

List all variations of your name.

A Form of Payment
