SERVICE AGREEMENT
ADDENDUM TWO

THIS ADDENDUM TO THE SERVICE AGREEMENT ("Addendum") is entered into this 1st day of December, 2014, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Adams County, Colorado, located at 4430 South Adams County Parkway, Brighton, CO 80601, hereinafter referred to as the "County," and **FRIENDS FIRST, INC.**, located at P.O. Box 270302, Littleton, Colorado 80127 hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor." The County and the Contractor may be collectively referred to herein as the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2013, the County entered into Addendum One #2013.231 with **Friends First, Inc.**, to provide Pregnancy Prevention, Health and Substance Abuse Services (High Risk Youth), and,

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor mutually desire to extend option year two of the Service Agreement effective January 1, 2015 pursuant to **Section 10 Change Orders and Extensions**.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration set forth herein, the sufficiency of which is mutually acknowledged by the parties, the County and the Contractor agree as follows:

1. The County shall pay the Contractor for the work furnished under this Addendum in accordance with **Section 3 Payment and Price Schedule Attachments A1-A7 of the Service Agreement RFP2012.229D** for a sum not to exceed eighty-one thousand dollars and no cents (\$81,000.00).
2. The term of the Service Agreement is extended for one (1) additional year effective through December 31, 2015.
3. The Service Agreement, Addendum One and Addendum Two contain the entire understanding of the parties hereto and neither it, nor the rights and obligations hereunder, may be changed, modified, or waived except by an instrument in writing that is signed by both parties. Any terms, conditions, or provisions of the Service Agreement that are not amended or modified by Addendum Two shall remain in full force and effect.

In the event of any conflicts between the terms, conditions, or provisions of the Service Agreement, Addendum One, and Addendum Two the terms, conditions, and provisions of Addendum Two shall prevail.

4. The Recitals contained in Addendum Two are incorporated into the body hereof, and accurately reflect the intent and agreement of the parties.
5. Addendum Two may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.

6. Nothing expressed or implied in Addendum Two is intended or shall be construed to confer upon or to give to, any person other than the parties, any right, remedy, or claim under or by reason of Addendum Two or any terms, conditions, or provisions hereof. All terms, conditions, and provisions in Addendum Two by and on behalf of the County and the Contractor shall be for the sole and exclusive benefit of the County and the Contractor.
7. If any provision of Addendum Two is determined to be unenforceable or invalid for any reason, the remainder of Addendum Two shall remain in effect, unless otherwise terminated in accordance with the terms contained in the Service Agreement.
8. Each party represents and warrants that it has the power and ability to enter into Addendum Two, to grant the rights granted herein, and to perform the duties and obligations herein described.
