- Community Development: Minor Home Repair Program continues in the Commerce City, Northglenn and unincorporated Adams County areas (brochures provided); staff has been working on the 5-year Consolidated Plan and 2015 Annual Action Plan for the office of Housing and Urban Development, which will be available online and at various locations; new website for neighborhood meeting information shared. - **Parks and Open Space:** Hyland Hills and Parks and Open Space are working together on future Regional Park located between Tennyson St. and Lowell Blvd. around 60<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- **Planning and Development:** Development Review Process explained (see attached handout).
- Sheriff's Office: Aaron Pataluna, Amanda Overton and Michael Kaiser are running the Community Connection Program, and are happy to attend community events; staffing discussed re: patrol units.
