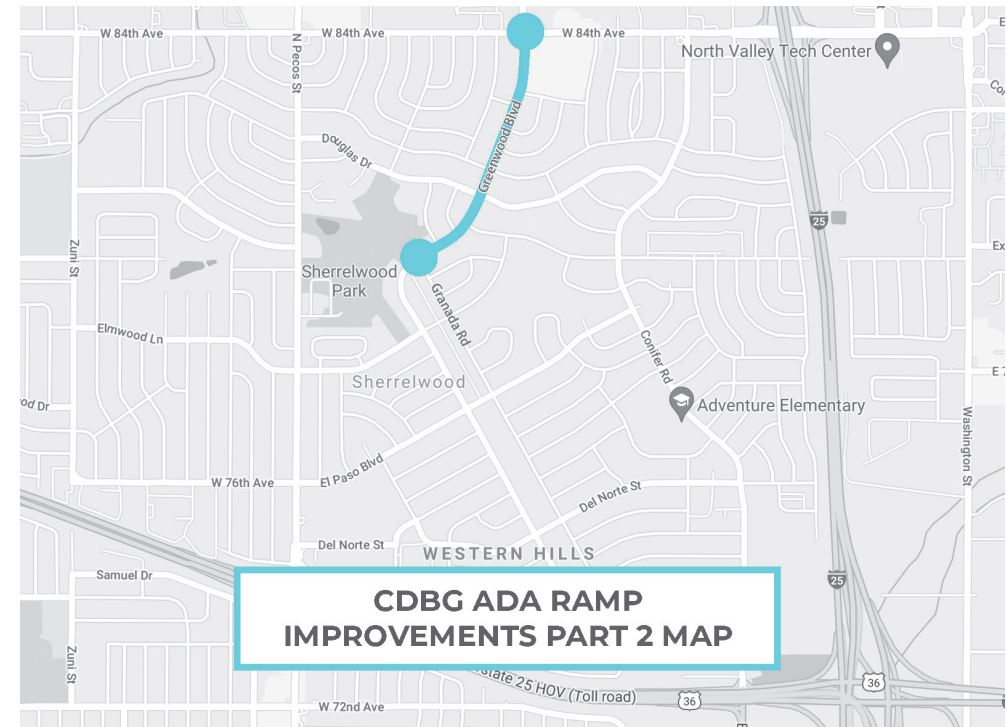

Project Overview

This project will continue improving the County's ADA Accessibility by removing 21 existing non-compliant pedestrian ramps and installing new ADA ramps along Greenwood Boulevard between Granada Road and 84th Avenue.

- Construction set to begin August 9, 2021
- Project will be completed in the Fall of 2021
- Project awarded to WGM Land Design for \$173,823.98
- All work is weather-dependant



Project Schedule & Traffic Impacts

Working Days/Hours

- Monday–Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Traffic Impacts

- There will be single lane closures throughout the project zone
- No detour route will be required
- Access to surrounding businesses and driveways will remain open at all times. Business/homeowners will be contacted directly when work is anticipated near their business/residence.

- Approximately 3-4 ramps will be removed and replaced per week
