Conservation Plan Amendment - Guide to Development Application Submittal

The submittal documents for all Land Use/Development Applications are listed below. Detailed explanations of the submittal documents are also provided.

All development application submittals shall comprise of one (1) electronic copy (emailed or delivered on a USB). Application submittals that do not conform to these guidelines shall not be accepted.

3. Written Explanation of the Project:

• A clear and concise, yet thorough, description of the proposal. Please include, if applicable, timeframe, purpose of project, and improvements that will be made to the site

4. Site Plan Showing Proposed Development:

- A detailed drawing of existing and proposed improvements
- Including:
 - Streets, roads, and intersections
 - Driveways, access points, and parking areas
 - Existing and proposed structures, wells, and septic systems,
 - Easements, utility lines, and no build or hazardous areas
 - Scale, north arrow, and date of preparation
- An Improvement Location Certificate or Survey <u>may be required</u> during the official review

5. Recommendation from Soil Conservation District Board:

• Written letter of recommendation from the appropriate Soil Conservation District Board (West Adams, East Adams, or Deer Trail)

6. Erosion and Sediment Control Plans:

- Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) plans are construction plans showing the proposed Best Management Practices, or BMP's, that will be used to mitigate erosion and the transport of sediment from a site under construction.
- ESC plans are often done in three (3) phases: Initial, Interim and, Final.
- These plans must also include installation details for each of the BMP's.

7. Proof of Ownership:

- A deed may be found in the Office of the Clerk and Recorder
- A title commitment is prepared by a professional title company

8. Legal Description:

- Geographical description used to locate and identify a property

9. Certificate of Taxes Paid:

- All taxes on the subject property must be paid in full. Please contact the Adams County Treasurer's Office

10-11. Certificate of Notice to Mineral Estate Owners/ Certificate of Surface Development:

- The State of Colorado requires notification to mineral rights owners of applications for surface development (i.e. zoning, plats, etc.)
- Mineral or Surface right owners may be found in the title commitment for the subject property
- You may also search the Office of the Clerk and Recorder for any recorded deeds, easements, or other documents.
