General Testing Information:

You must visit MyGED® at www.GED.com to sign up and create your MyGED® account.

The GED test is \$37.50 (per subject) and there are four subjects for an overall total of \$150.00

You can take a test module, and two subsequent module retests, with no restrictions between retakes. If you fail the second or any subsequent retest, the test taker must wait 60 days for each successive attempt. You can take one or two tests each session.

GET STARTED:

1. Create a Connecting Colorado account. This can be done at the Workforce Center or online at www.connectingcolorado.com.
2. Once Connecting Colorado registration is complete, email WBCGED@adcogov.org to register for the GED program.
3. You will be contacted with login information to access the pre-assessments.
4. Complete all pre-assessments and notify the program administrator once complete.
5. Your scores will be reviewed, and you will be contacted with a learning plan.
